## BARBARA ANN WILL RECEIVE LOU MARSH TROPHY TONIGHT

Barbara Ann Scott, Olympic skating queen, is to be guest of honour at a dinner and dance in the Crystal ballroom of the King Edward tonight. The occasion will be featured by presentation to her of the Lou Marsh Memorial Trophy, as the outstanding Canadian athlete of 1947. She previously won the cup in 1945.

Presentation is to be made by Charles Ring, donor of the trophy and chairman of the cup committee.

The guests, numbering 350, will be made up of members and friends of the Lions club of Toronto, Central, Argonaut Rowing club and the Good Fellowship club.
